

We would like to confirm that the golf course & food/beverage take out can remain open. Governor DeSantis "Stay at Home" executive order does not affect us, however, we will still have a restriction on "only "allowing Martin County residents access to our golf facility. We are undertaking these measures to protect our members, guests, team members and the community to provide a safer haven from COVID 19.

We are hoping this is short-lived and that we can welcome back our loyal patrons who frequent our facility.

With that said, we at Crane Watch have added further changes to our normal day to day operations to enhance the safety of our members, guests and team members which are as follows:

- 1) Bathroom area sanitation schedules increased.***
- 2) Locker room areas sanitation schedules increased.***
- 3) High traffic areas sanitized more regularly.***
- 4) Rounds at all entry/exit doors to wipe handles increases.***
- 5) Walking permitted. Cart not required.***
- 6) Golf staff is wiping down all golf carts with sanitizing products.***
- 7) Removal of all water stations and ice chests. Bottled water is available at a reduced price.***
- 8) Removal of all ball washers.***
- 9) Bunker rakes have been removed. All bunkers have been deemed a "non-hazard". Due to this precautionary measure, we have adopted a local rule which allows the ball to be placed in the bunker or adjacent to it. This will not affect your handicap if you are putting in a score per the USGA.***
- 10) Driving range stations to be placed further apart. All driving range balls are thoroughly washed with water and detergent with our ball washing machine.***
- 11) As a further precaution, we have inserted a piece of foam which is less than an inch from the putting surface, allowing golfers not having to touch the flagstick or cup.***
- 12) One person per cart ridership with the exception of spouse, significant other or family members.***
- 13) Red tape is being used as a marker to designate 6 ft. a social distancing zone.***
- 14) Counters & tops are regularly sanitized.***
- 15) Installation of a plexiglass barrier on the golf shop counter to protect members & team members.***
- 16) Golf operations golf course monitoring, ensuring social distancing guidelines are observed.***

Additionally, all Team Members are being encouraged that should they not feel well to please refrain from coming to work during this period of uncertainty. We would encourage Members and Guests to follow this practice.
